- technical nature, i.e. non-commercial
- The deadline for abstracts is the 26th of February, 2024. Presenters will be notified by the first week of May as to whether or not their proposed presentation has been accepted by the Steering Committee.
- Consequently, they will be invited to submit the PowerPoint (or equivalent) to accompany you during your presentation. The deadline for **sending in** presentation materials is the 30th of September, 2024.
